



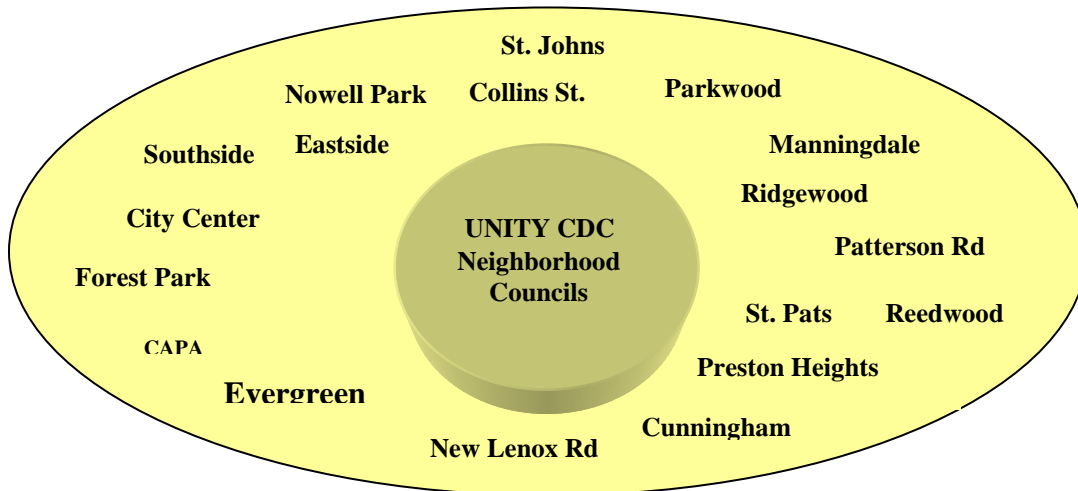
UNITY CDC NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL
